

Vintage Ripple Fan Scarf Crochet Pattern

Crochet Hook: H/8 or 5 mm hook

Yarn Weight: (4 colors) Medium Weight/Worsted Weight

Important Note: All stitches are made in the **back loop only**.

- 1. With color A, Ch 55 stitches. (The scarf in the photo is a bit wider- if you want to add to the width, each fan is 9 stitches)
- 2. Start with second chain from hook. Do a sc in each of the next 4 st. (Do 3sc in the next stitch, then another sc in each of the next 8 st.)
- *repeat until last 4 stitches. Do a sc in each of the last four stitches. Chain 1, turn.
- 3. (Skip one sc. One sc in each of the next 4 st, 3 sc in the next, one sc in each of the next 4
- st. Skip two sc.) *repeat this to the end of the row. Chain 1, turn.
- 4. Same as row 3. Chain 1, turn.
- 5. Slip-stitch into the next 3 sc, back-loop only. Chain up 6 (this counts as the first dtr in the first fan). Do a dtr in each of the next 2 stitches, 3dtr in the next, and a dtr in each of the next 3 stitches. Skip 4 sc. (Do a dtr in each of the next 3 sc, 3dtr in the next, and a dtr in each of the next 3 sc. Skip 4 sc.) *repeat to the end of the row. Chain 1, turn. (See video to help with this row)

Rows 6-8- repeat rows 2-4. Change to color B

For each color strip from this point on, repeat row 5 and then rows 2-4, changing colors after row 4. Continue with the pattern until the scarf is at the desired length. Continue with the pattern until the scarf is at the desired length.
