



Island Breezes - 2 Easy Patterns!

Create something beautiful! Included in this booklet are instructions to create :

Island Breezes Hot Pads - Size: 8" x 8"

Island Breezes Lap Quilt Size: 52" x 64"



Island Breezes Hot Pads



To Make 1 Hot Pad, you will use: (Fabric amounts include extra and colors are just suggestions)

- 1/4 yard white fabric
- 1/3 yard ea. light teal, medium teal, and dark teal fabric
- 1 fat quarter of fabric of your choice for backing
- 1/4 yard of fabric of your choice for binding
- Insulated Batting

Cut the Following:


- (12 ea.) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares white fabric
- (6 ea.) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" light teal fabric squares
- (8 ea.) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" medium teal fabric squares
- (6 ea.) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" dark teal fabric squares
- 8-1/2" x 8-1/2" square fabric of your choice for backing
- 2-1/2" x 36" strip fabric of your choice for binding

Step 1: Place two squares right sides together. Sew diagonally from one corner to the opposite as shown to the right. Make the following:

- 2 ea. Dk Teal/White
- 2 ea. Lt Teal and White
- 4 ea. Lt Teal and Dk Teal
- 4 ea. Md. Teal and White

Step 2: Clip 1/4" from seam.

Step 3: Press open, resulting in a 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" square.





Step 4: Place a Dk Teal/Lt Teal square and a Md Teal square right sides together. Sew diagonally from one corner to the opposite as shown to the above.

Step 5: Clip 1/4" from seam.

Step 6: Press open, resulting in a 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" square. (Make 4 of these COMBO Blocks)

Step 7 (A): With right sides together, using 1/4" seams, sew a white square to a Dk Teal/White square as shown above. (Make 2). With right sides together, using 1/4" seams, sew a white square to a Lt Teal/White square as shown above. (Make 2).

Step 7 (B): With right sides together, using 1/4" seams, sew a COMBO Block to a Md Teal/White square as shown above. (Make 4).

Step 7 (C): With right sides together, using 1/4" seams, sew Block A to Block B as shown above. Create 2 of each color combination for a total of (4 ea) 4-1/2" blocks.



Step 8: With right sides together, using 1/4" seams, sew the blocks together as shown above. The block will now measure 8-1/2" x 8-1/2".



Step 9: Layer the block top with a 8-1/2" x 8-1/2" square of insulated batting and the backing as shown above. Quilt the three layers together with your favorite method. Add binding using your favorite method.



Island Breezes Quilt Pattern- Size 52" x 64"


You will use:

2 yards white fabric
3/4 yard ea. light teal, medium teal, and dark teal fabric
3/4 yard ea. light blue, medium blue, and dark blue fabric
3 yards fabric of your choice for backing
1/2 yard dark blue for sashing
1/2 yard fabric of your choice for binding

Note: The blocks for the quilt measure 12-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished.

Cut the Following:

(240 ea.) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" squares white fabric
(60 ea.) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" light teal fabric squares
(80 ea.) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" medium teal fabric squares
(60 ea.) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" dark teal fabric squares
(60 ea.) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" light blue fabric squares
(80 ea.) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" medium blue fabric squares
(60 ea.) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" dark blue fabric squares
(2 ea.) 2-1/2" x 48-1/2" strips dark blue (sashing-sew strips together to get the length)
(2 ea.) 2-1/2" x 64-1/2" strips dark blue (sashing-sew strips together to get the length)



Assembly

Step 1: Create (20) ea. 12-1/2" x 12-1/2" Blocks following the instructions for the hot pads.

Step 2: With right sides together, using a 1/4" seam, sew four blocks together as in Row A, alternating the block colors as shown. Create a total of 5 rows as shown.

Step 3: With right sides together, using a 1/4" seam, sew the rows together. The quilt top will now measure 48-1/2" x 60-1/2".

Step 4: Sew the 2-1/2" x 48-1/2" borders to top and bottom. (You will have to sew strips together in order to get the length). Add the side borders. Quilt top will now measure 52-1/2" x 64-1/2".

Step 5: Lay backing fabric right-side down. Place a layer of batting over top, and then the quilt top (right side up) on top. Baste all three layers together to prepare for quilting. (I generally hand baste with very long (6") stitches, diagonally, horizontally and vertically across the quilt through all three layers. Quilt and bind using your favorite methods.
