

Pennsylvania Dutch Heritage - Block 9

1. Cut a 12-1/2" x 12-1/2" square of white fabric to be used as the background for block 9.
2. Each block pattern includes a two page actual size drawing of the finished block. Tape the two pages together, and use this as a basis for putting together your block.
3. Use the Block 9 templates to cut out the individual pieces of fabric in your choice of colors. *(Be sure to add a seam allowance if you are doing traditional applique).*

Note: *For some forms of applique, you will need to flip your templates over when cutting.*

Applique the pieces in place starting with the pieces in the back. **(All template pieces are numbered in order of assembly).** Once all pieces are sewn in place, embroider as desired.

Embroidery Tips

--Use transfer paper to transfer embroidery pattern onto background fabric, or carefully mark with heat erasable fabric pens.

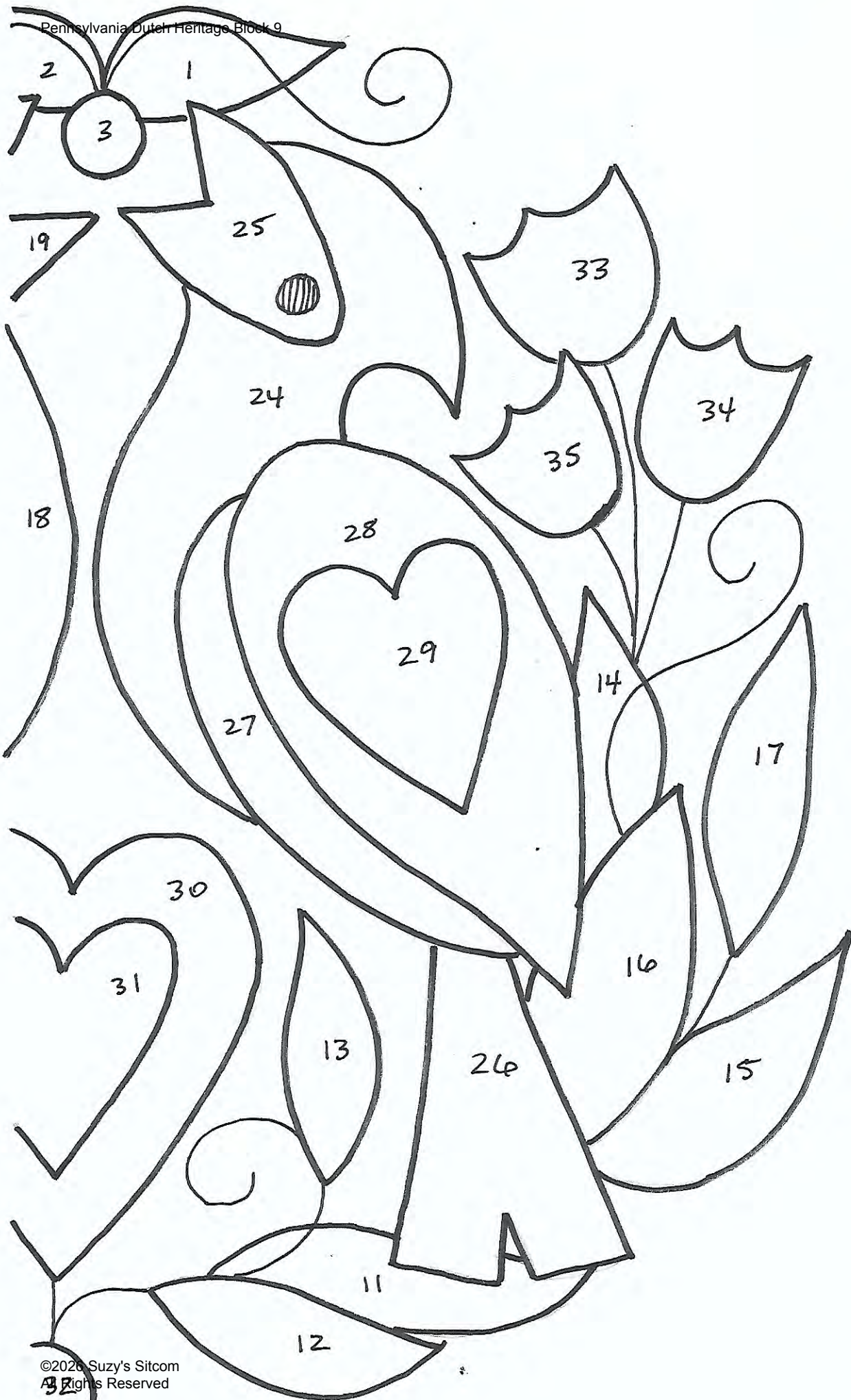


Embroidery Floss Colors:

Black

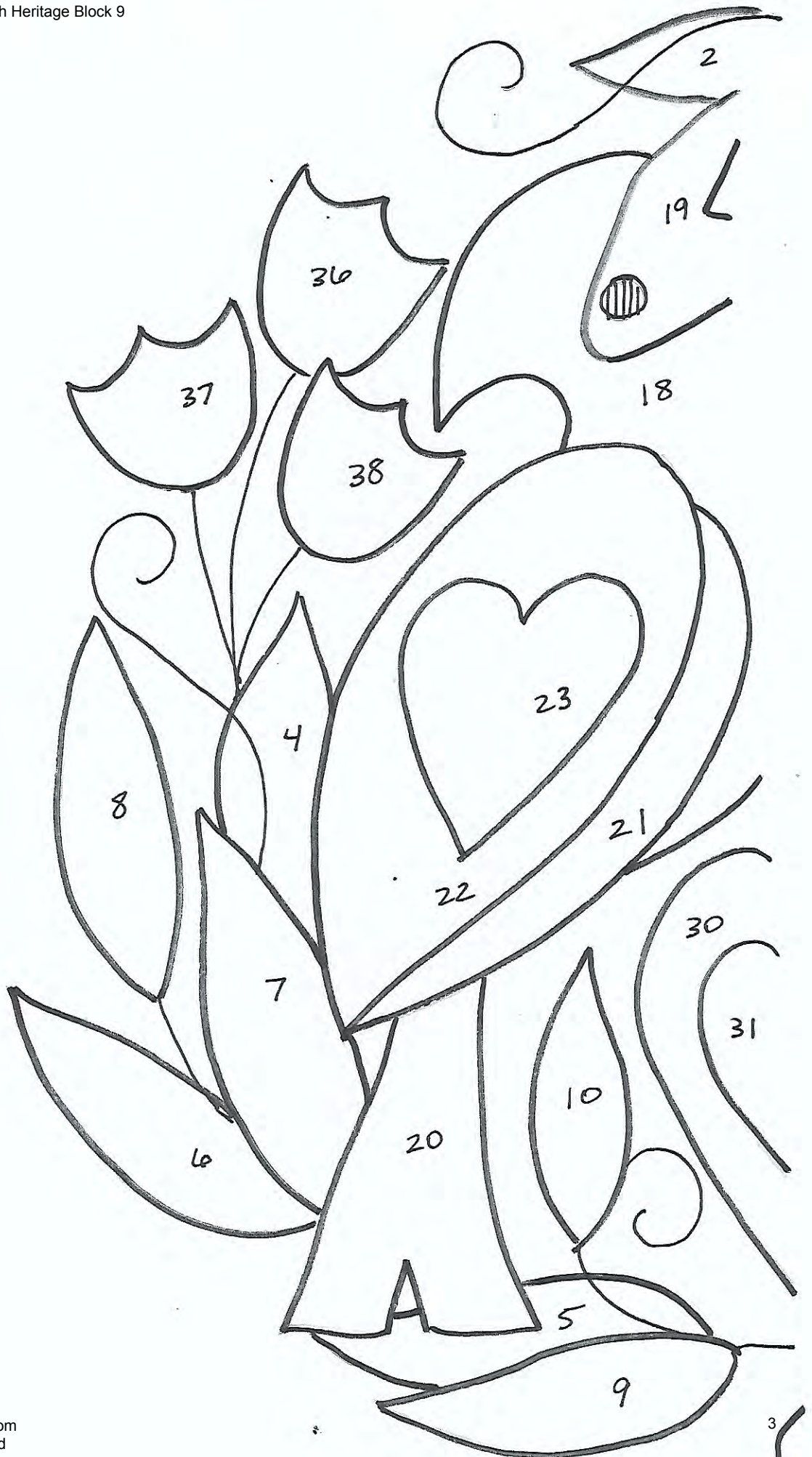
Split Stitch- (3 strands)-
stems

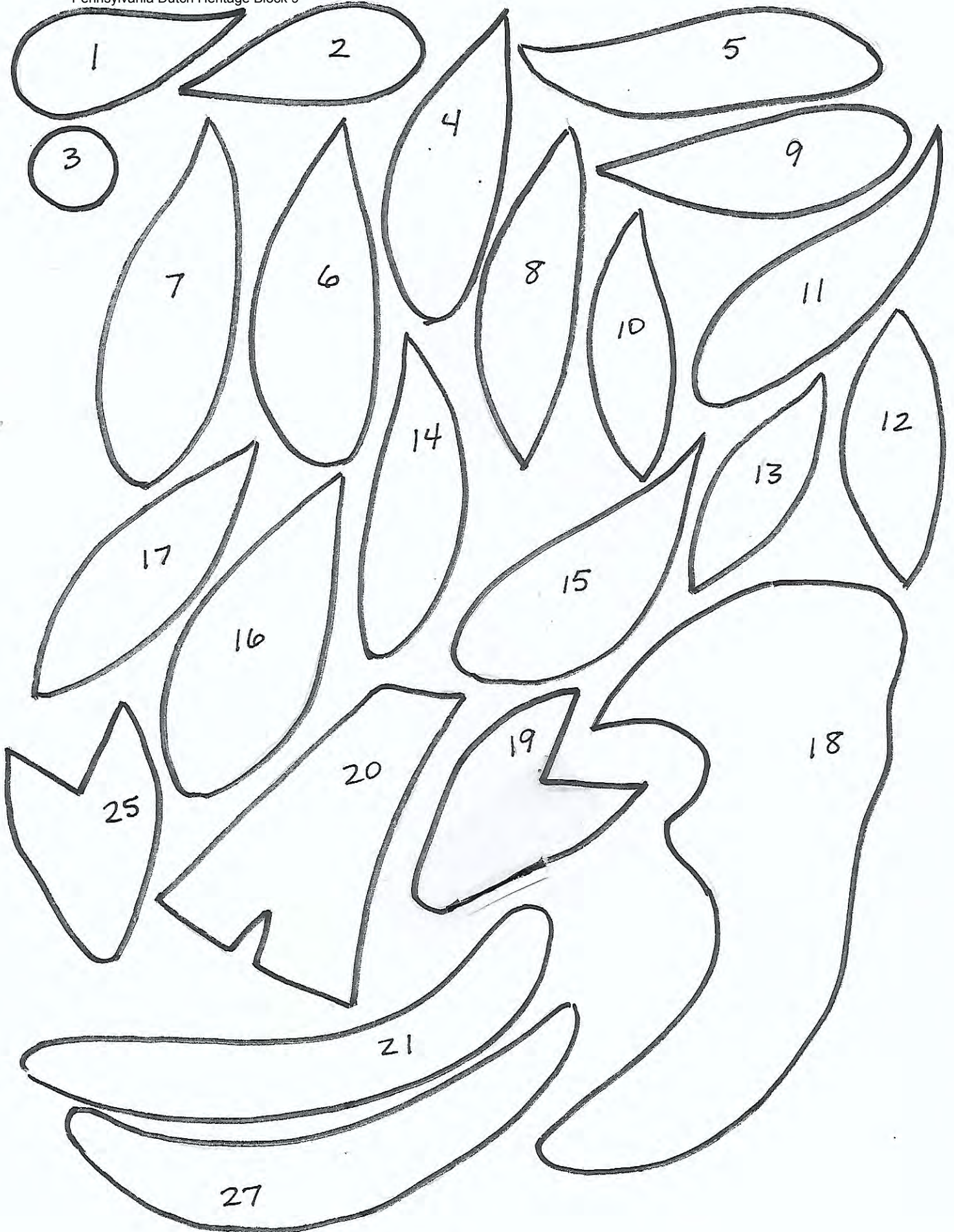
Satin Stitch (3 strands)- eyes

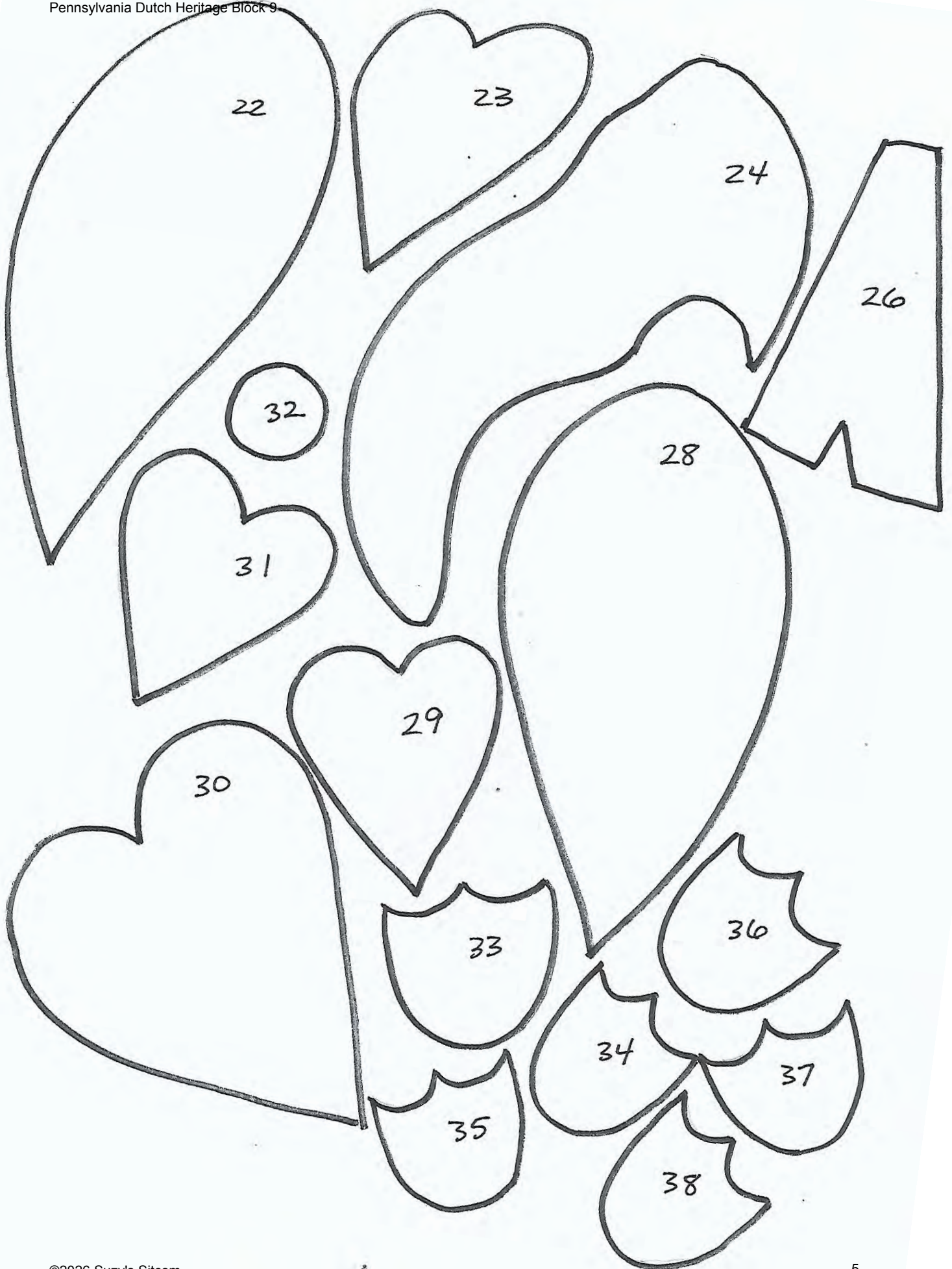

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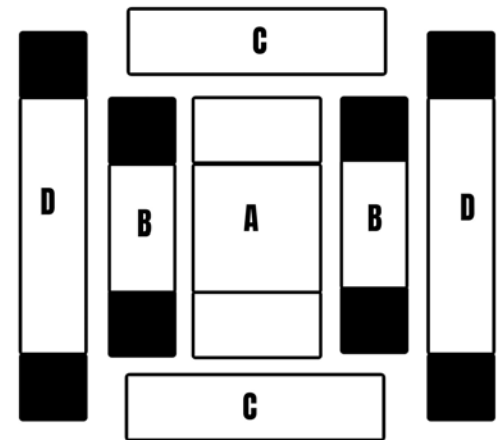
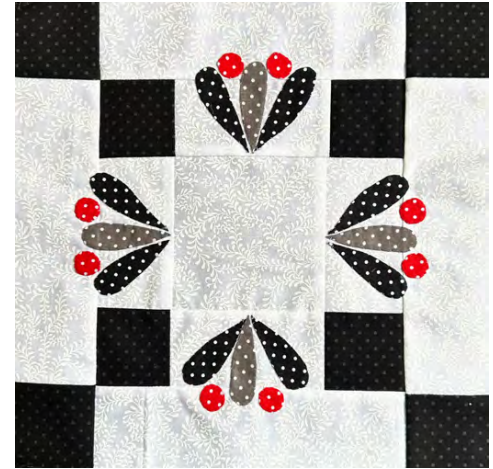


Instructions for Filler Block

For each filler block, cut the following:

- (1 ea.) 4-1/2" x 4-1/2" square white
- (4 ea.) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles white
- (4 ea.) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles white
- (8 ea.) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares Swiss Dots Tone on Tone Black

1. With right sides together and using 1/4" seams, sew two of the 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" white rectangles to each side of the 4-1/2" white square. (A) Press.
2. With right sides together and using 1/4" seams, sew two of the 2-1/2" black squares to each end of the remaining 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" white rectangles. (B) Press.
3. With right sides together and using 1/4" seams, sew the two (B) units to the (A) unit as shown to the right. Press.
4. With right sides together and using 1/4" seams, sew two of the 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" white rectangles (C) to the top and bottom of the unit created in step 3.
5. With right sides together and using 1/4" seams, sew two of the 2-1/2" black squares to each end of the remaining 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" white rectangles. (D). Press.
6. With right sides together and using 1/4" seams, sew the two (D) units to the unit from step 5. As shown. Press. Block will now measure 12-1/2" x 12-1/2" and is ready for applique.



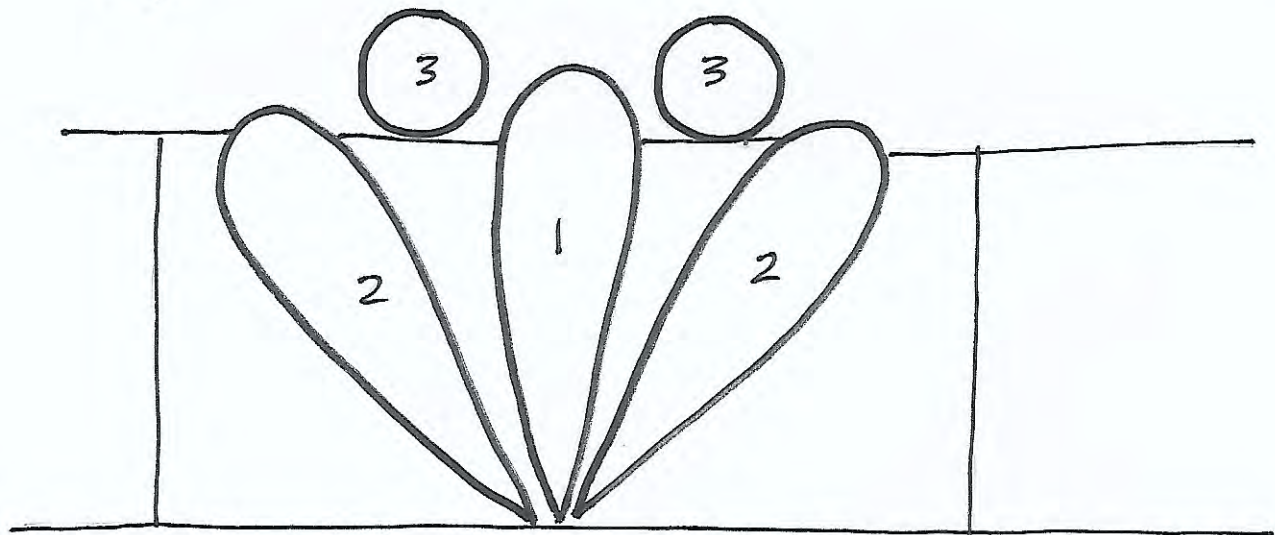
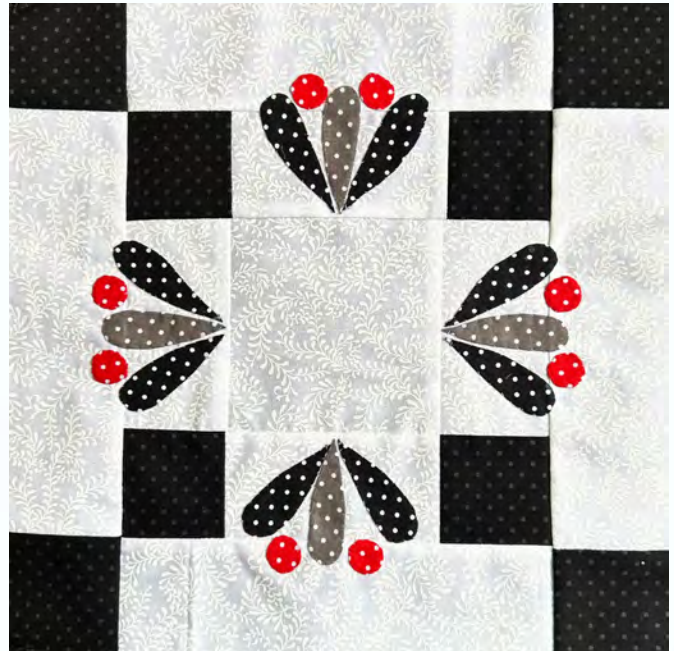
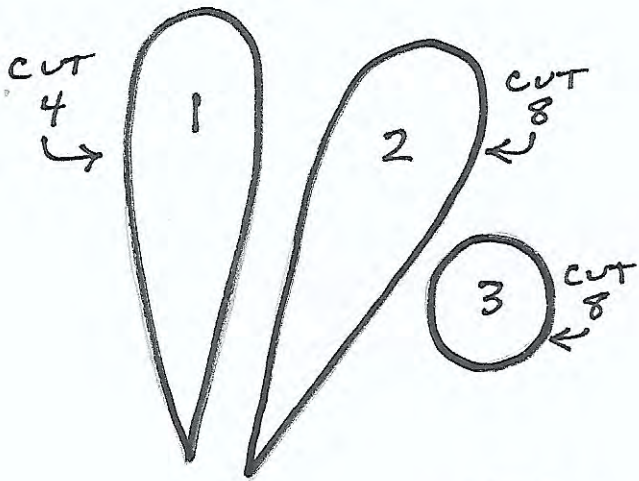
You will need a total of 13 Filler Blocks to complete this quilt pattern.



Filler Block Applique

1. Be sure to print this page at 100%.
2. Use the templates as shown below to cut out the individual pieces of fabric in your choice of colors. (Be sure to add a seam allowance if you are doing traditional applique).
Note: For some forms of applique, you will need to flip your templates over when cutting.
3. Applique the pieces in place starting with the pieces in the back. (All template pieces are numbered in order of assembly).
