

Bearadise- Block 5



Block Cutting and Assembly

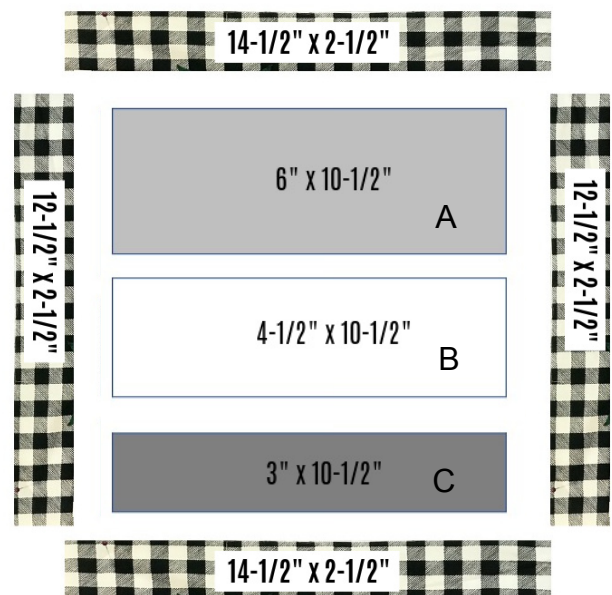
Cutting

- (1 ea) 6" x 10-1/2" Light Gray Strip
- (1 ea.) 4-1/2" x 10-1/2" White print strip
- (1 ea.) 3" x 10-1/2" Dark Gray strip
- (2 ea.) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" Plaid strips
- (2 ea.) 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" Plaid strips

Assembly

1. With right sides together and using a 1/4" seam, sew the gray strip (A) to the white print strip (B) along the long edge. Press.
2. With right sides together and using a 1/4" seam, sew the white print strip (B) to the dark gray strip (C) along the long edge. Press.
3. With right sides together and using a 1/4" seam, sew each 12-1/2" x 2-1/2" plaid strip to the sides of the block. Press.
4. With right sides together and using a 1/4" seam, sew each 14-1/2" x 2-1/2" plaid strip to the top and bottom of the block. Press.

Block 5 will now measure 14-1/2" x 16-1/2". It is now ready for applique!



Applique and Embroidery Instructions

--Use the Block 5 templates to cut out the individual pieces of fabric in your choice of colors.

(Be sure to add a seam allowance if you are doing traditional applique).

Note: For traditional applique and fused applique, you will need to flip your templates over when cutting.

Applique the pieces in place starting with the pieces in the back. (**All template pieces are numbered for ease of assembly**).

Once all pieces are sewn in place, embroider as desired.



Suggested Embroidery Stitches

--Use transfer paper to transfer embroidery pattern onto background fabric, or carefully mark with heat erasable fabric pens.

Easy Applique Tip!

Use a clear sheet protector to trace the pattern. Use the sheet protector as a template when assembling applique pieces.



Embroidery Floss Colors:

Black, Light brown, Green

Chain Stitch - (3 strands)- Stem

Satin Stitch- (3 strands) Eyes, Nose, Toes

Split Stitch- (3 strands)- mouth, fishing rod line



Partial Quilt Assembly

Cut the following:

- 2 ea. 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" black plaid strips
- 2 ea. 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" black plaid strips

Step 1: With right sides together and using a 1/4" seam, sew a 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" strip to the right hand side of block #1. Press.

Step 2: With right sides together, matching seams and using a 1/4" seam, sew two of the red and white filler blocks together. Press.

Step 3: With right sides together and using a 1/4" seam, sew the unit from Step 2 to the bottom of block #1. Press. With right sides together and using 1/4" seam, sew a 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" strip to the bottom of this unit. Press. **(Unit A as shown below).**

Step 4: With right sides together and using a 1/4" seam, sew a red and white filler block to the right hand side of block #2. Press. **(Unit B as shown below).**

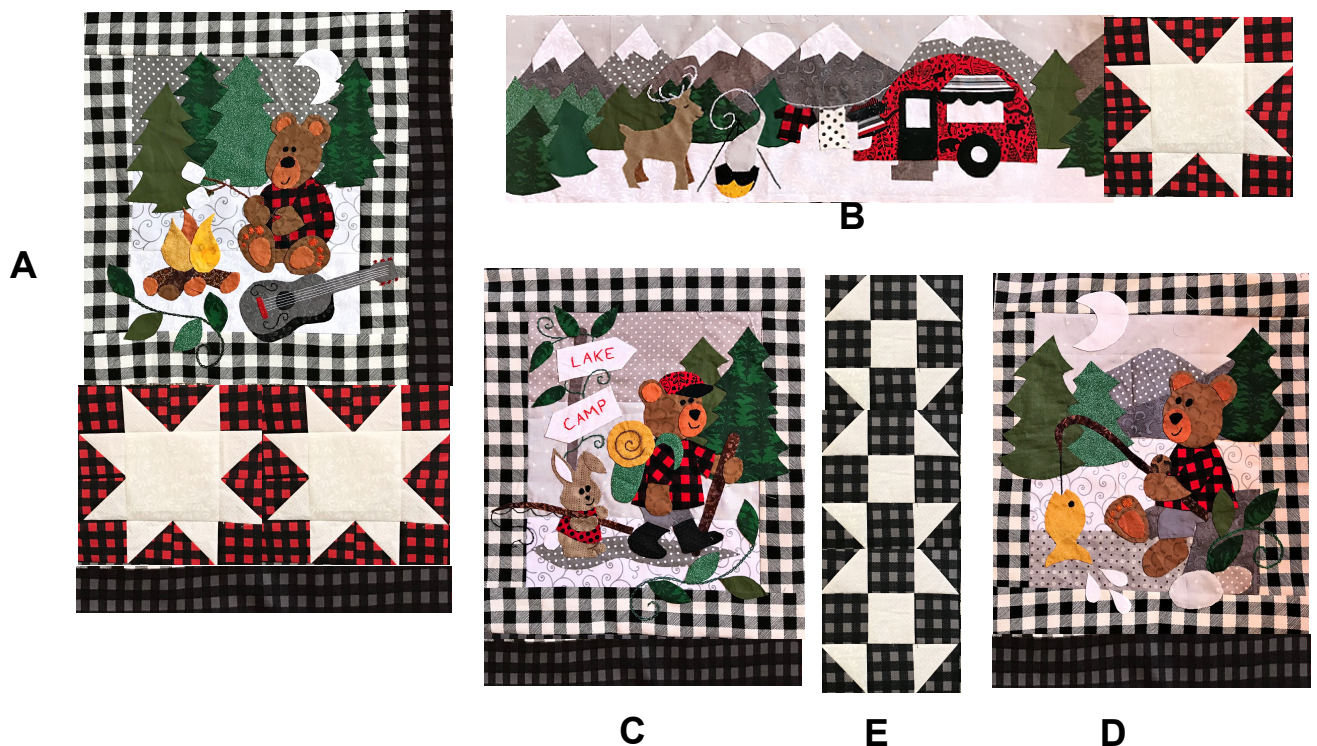
Step 5: With right sides together and using a 1/4" seam, sew a 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" strip to the bottom of each of block #4 and block #5. **(Units C and D as shown below).** Press.

Step 6: With right sides together and using 1/4" seams, sew together 3 of the black and white filler blocks as shown below **(Unit E).** Press.

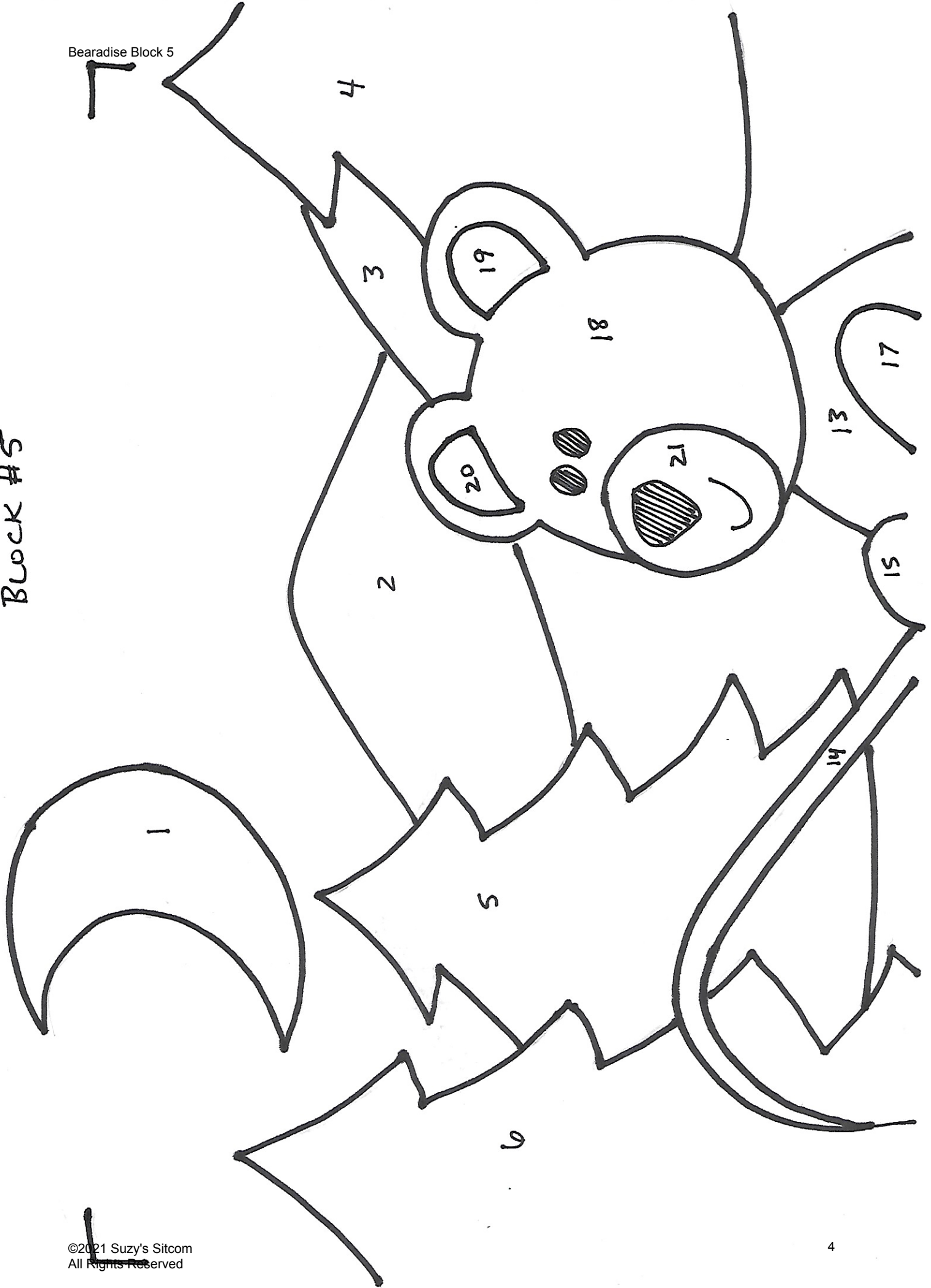
Step 7: With right sides together and using 1/4" seams, sew units C, D and E together as shown.

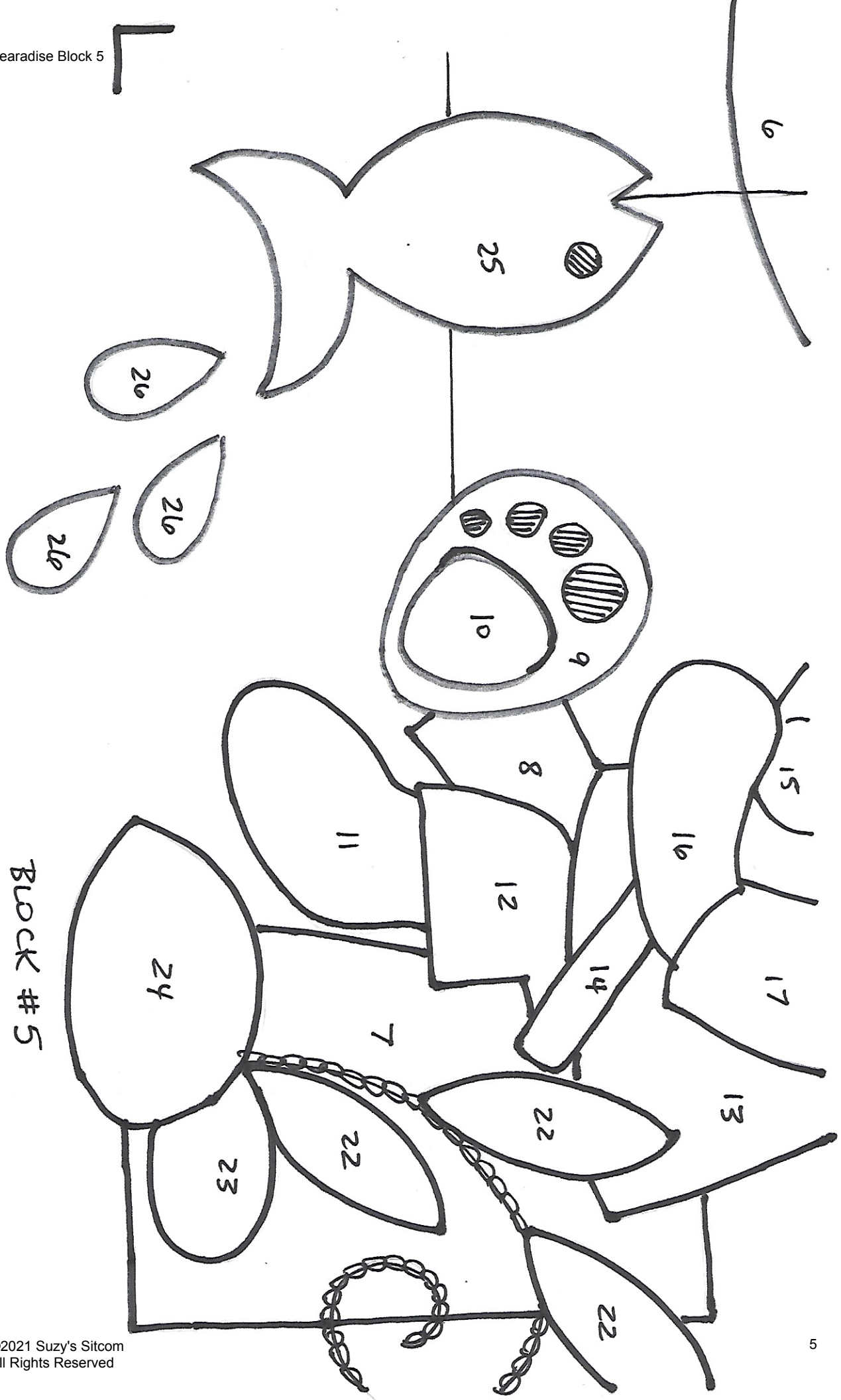
Step 8: With right sides together and using a 1/4" seam, sew Unit B to the top of the unit from step 7. Press.

Step 9: With right sides together and using 1/4" seams, sew Unit A to the left of the unit from Step 8. Press.

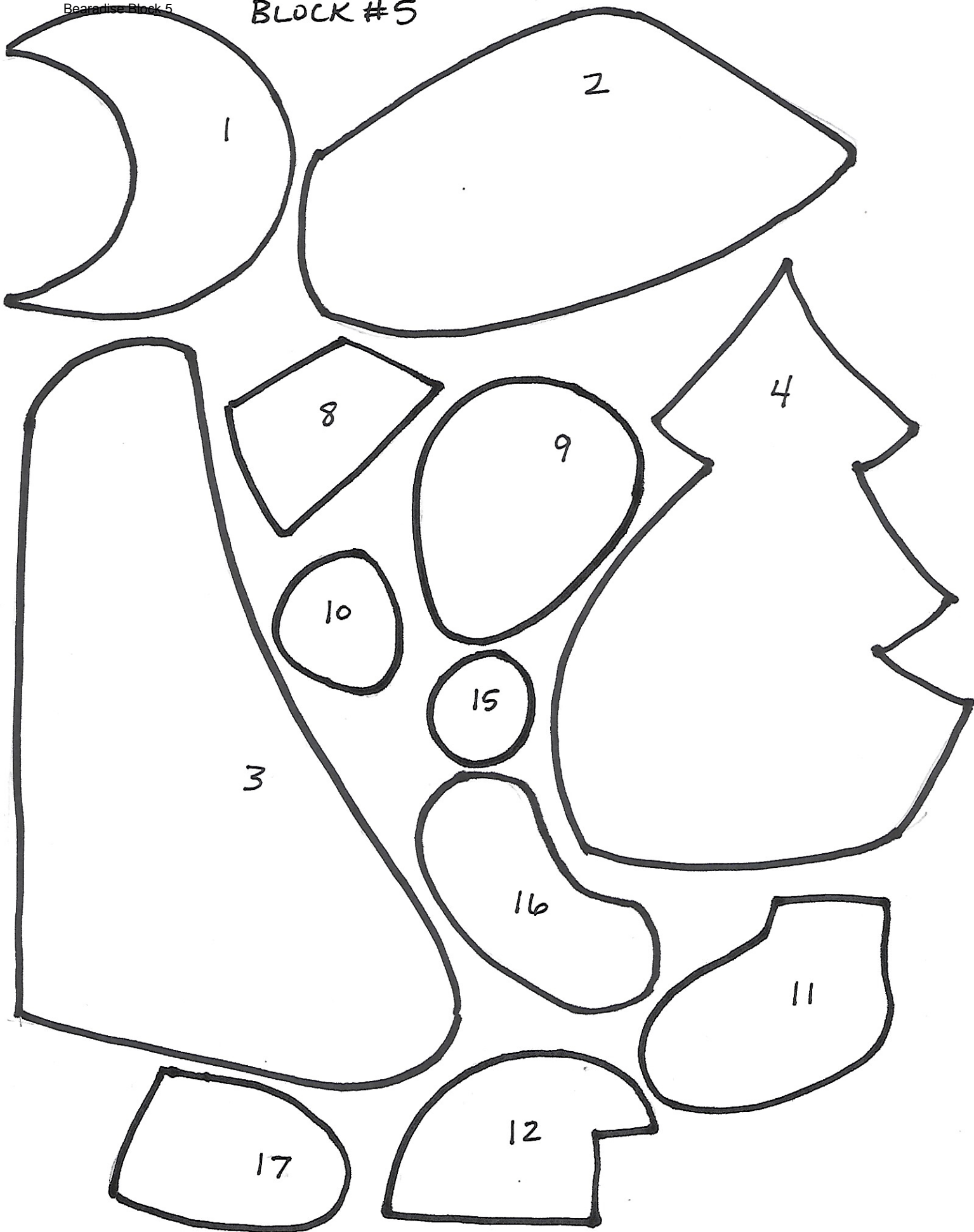

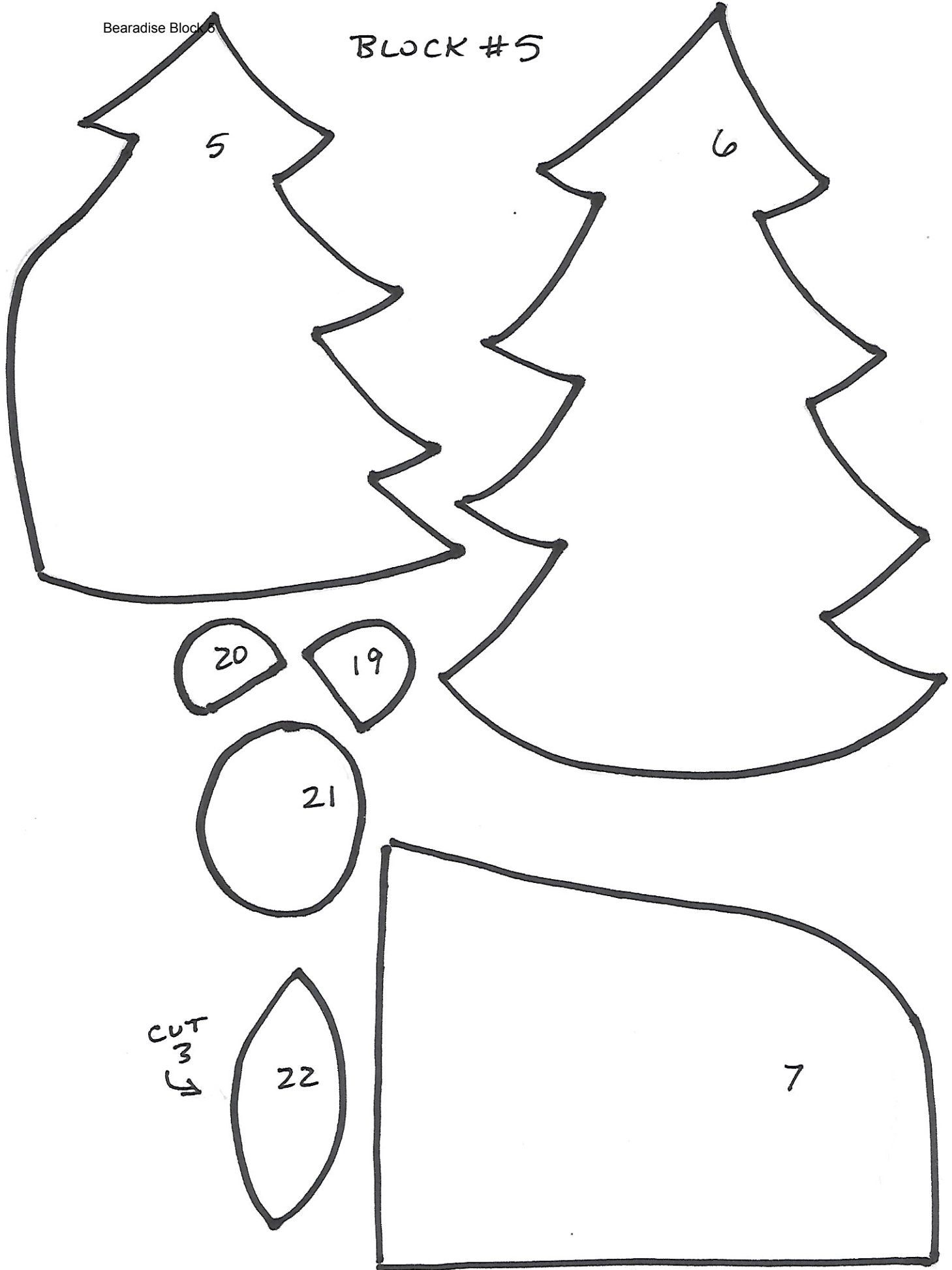




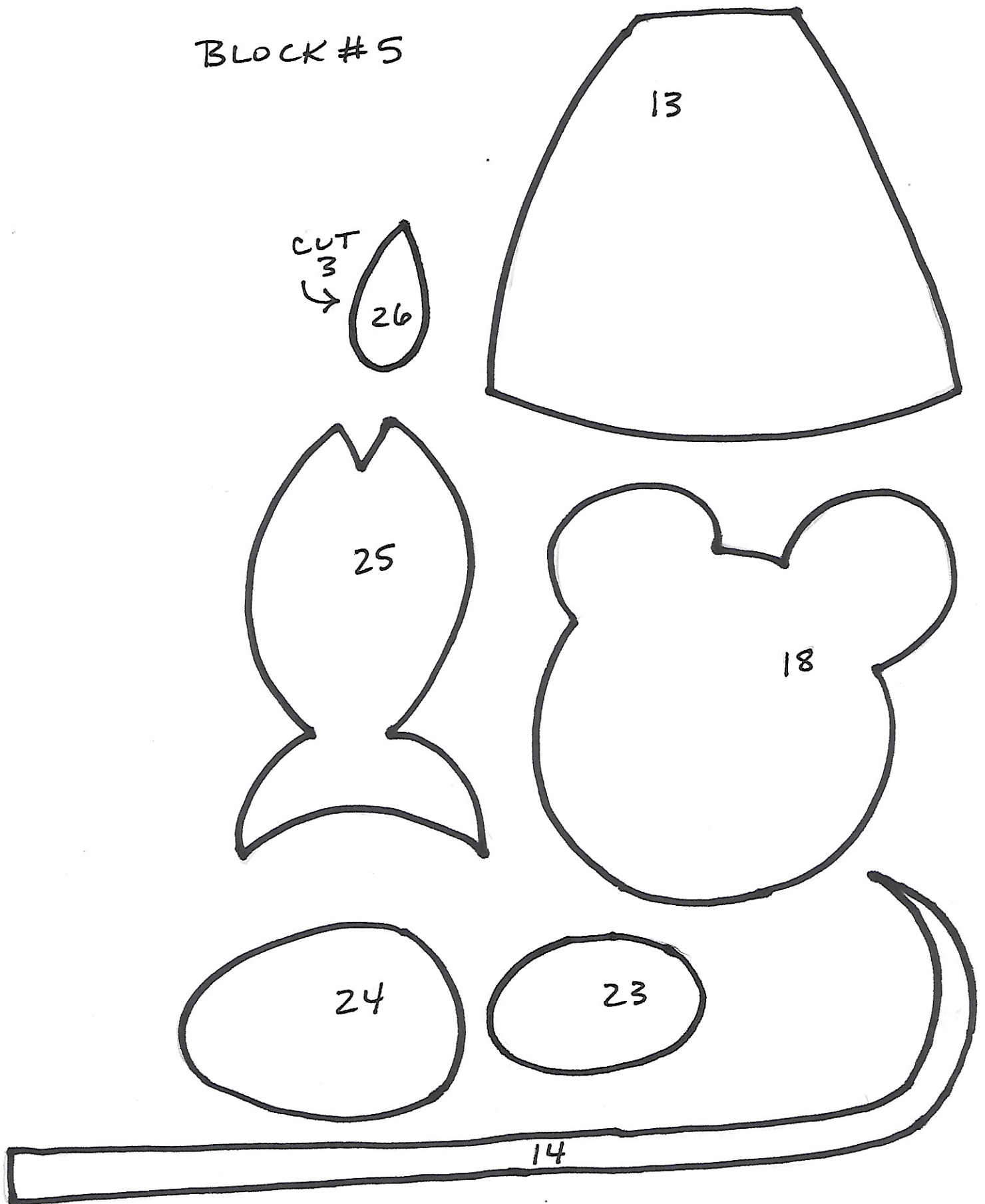
