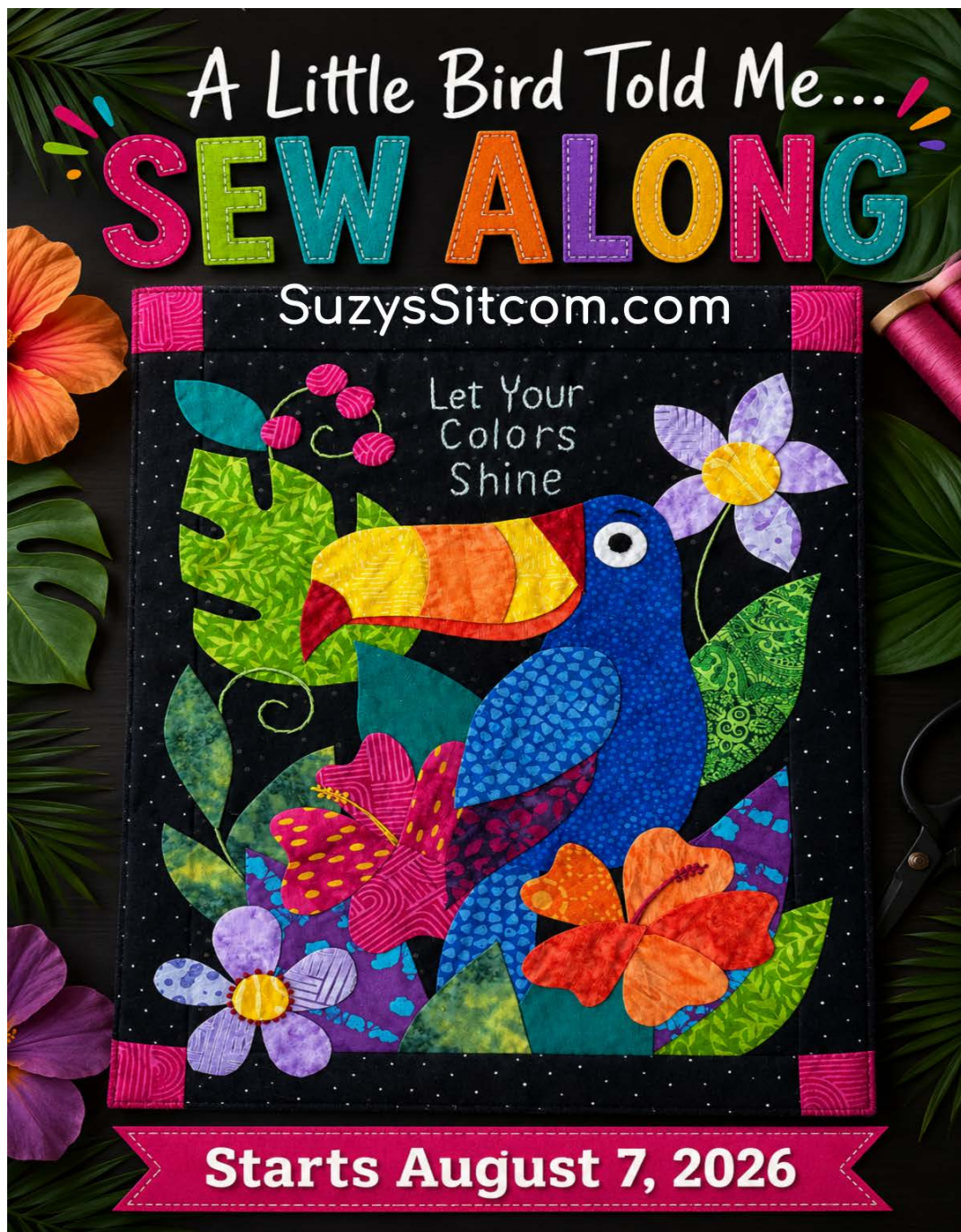




A Little Bird Told Me

Finished Quilt Measures 60" x 74"

Block 1 Measures: 12" x 16"



A Little Bird Told Me- Block 1



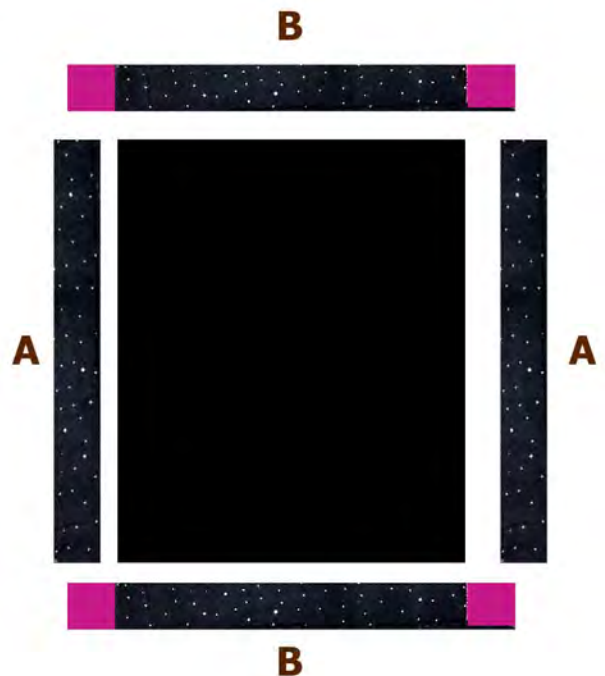
Cut the Following:

- 1 ea. 10-1/2" x 14-1/2" rectangle black fabric for the background
- 2 ea. 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips black dot fabric
- 2 ea. 1-1/2" x 14-1/2" strips black dot fabric
- 4 ea. 1-1/2" squares bright pink

Assembly

1. With right sides together and using a 1/4" seam, sew the 1-1/2" x 14-1/2" black dot strips to each side of the 10-1/2" x 14-1/2" background fabric. (A) Press.
2. With right sides together and using a 1/4" seam, sew each 1-1/2" pink square to each end of the 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" black dot strips.(B) Press.
3. With right sides together and using a 1/4" seam, sew the units created in Step 2 to the top and bottom of the unit created in Step 1. Press.

The block will now measure 12-1/2" x 16-1/2" and is ready for applique.



Applique and Embroidery Instructions

--Use the Block 1 templates to cut out the individual pieces of fabric in your choice of colors.

(Be sure to add a seam allowance if you are doing traditional applique).

Note: For traditional applique and fused applique, you will need to flip your templates over when cutting.

Applique the pieces in place starting with the pieces in the back. (**All template pieces are numbered for ease of assembly**).

Once all pieces are sewn in place, embroider as desired.

Suggested Embroidery Stitches

--Use transfer paper to transfer embroidery pattern onto background fabric, or carefully mark with heat erasable fabric pens.



Embroidery Floss Colors:

Bright Green, Red, Yellow, Light Blue, Black

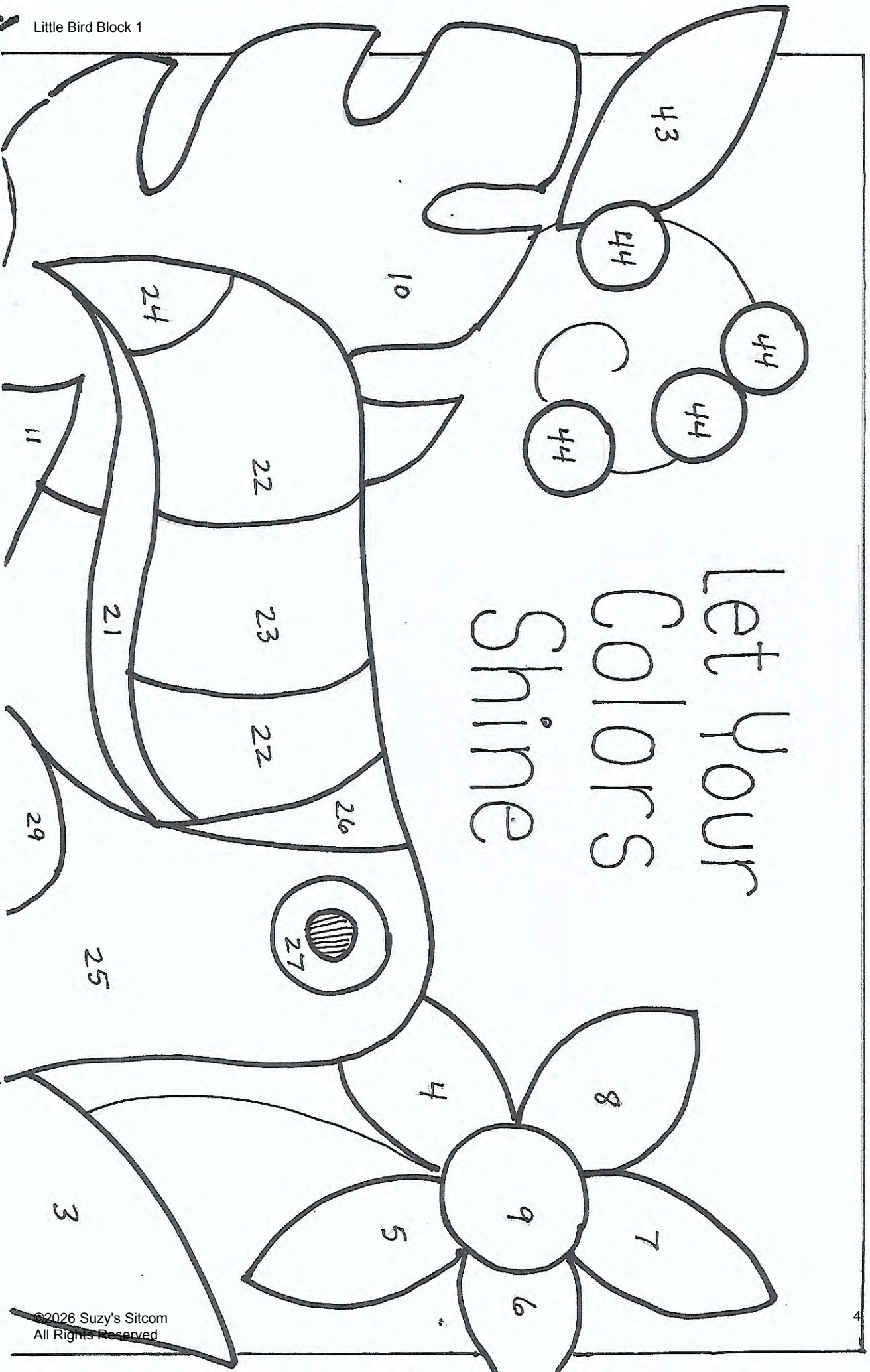
Split Stitch - (3 strands)- Stems, LET YOUR COLORS SHINE

Satin Stitch- (3 strands) Eye, Flower Stamens

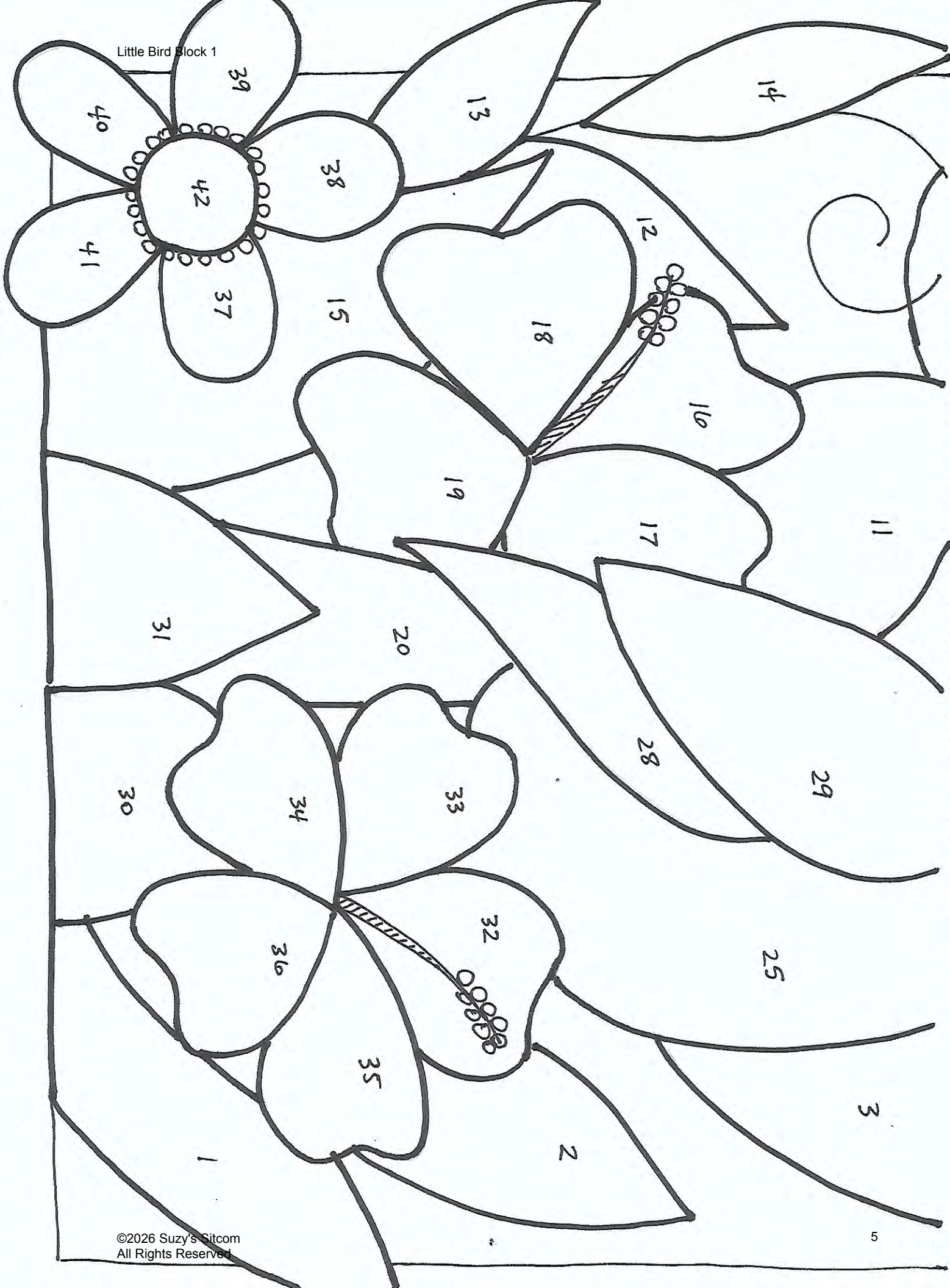
French Knot- (3 strands)- Flower Stamens

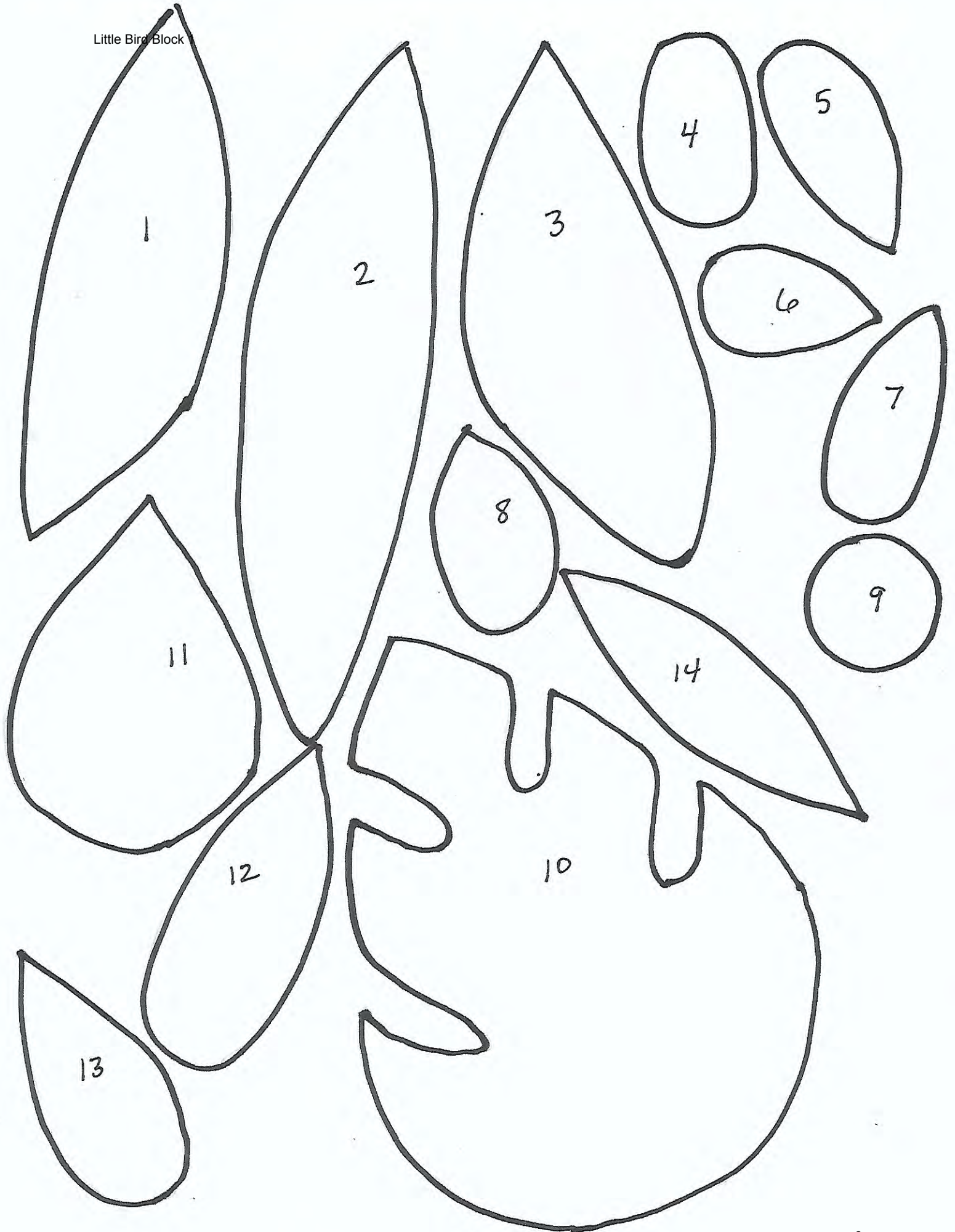

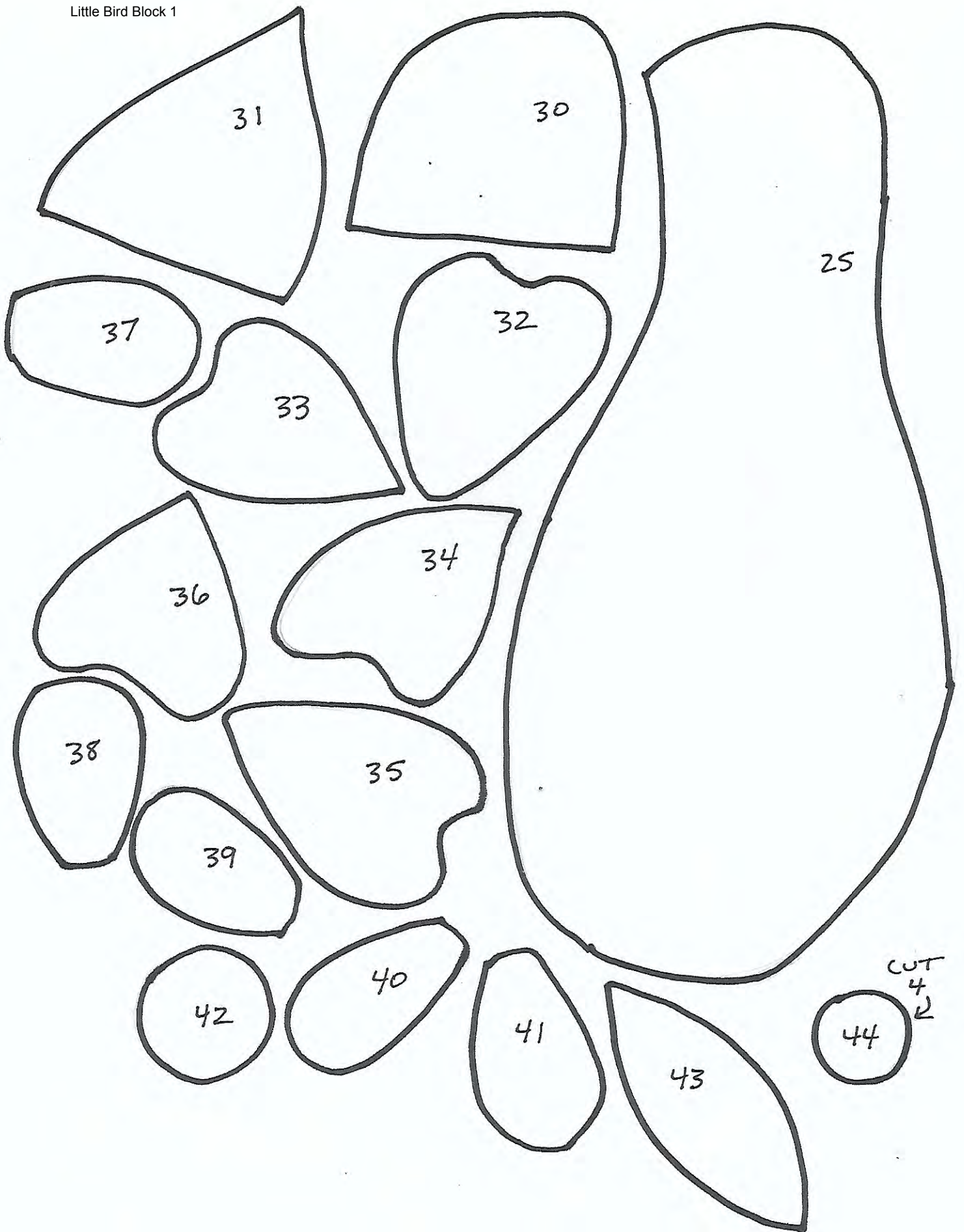


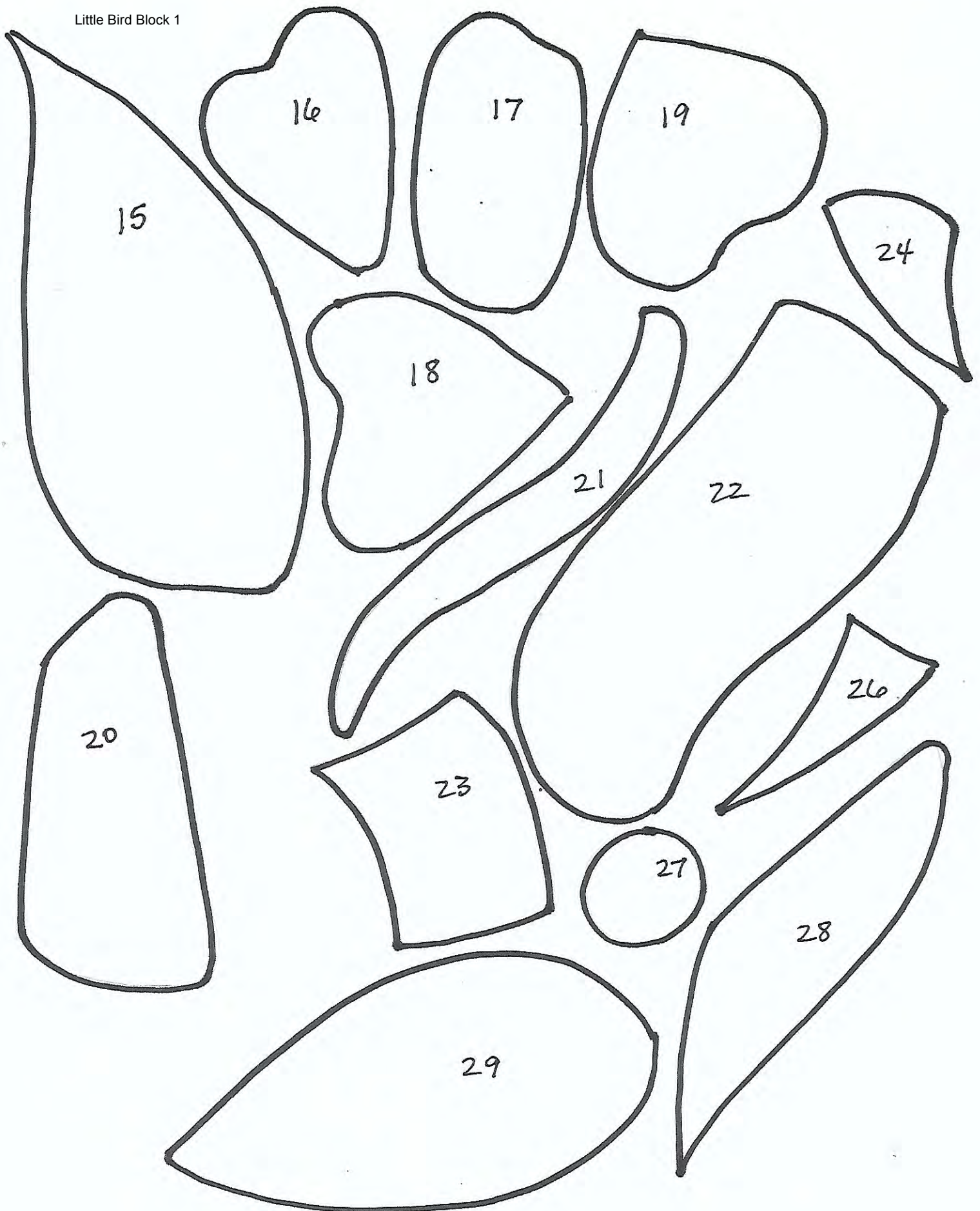
