



Pike Stitch Instructions

The Pike Stitch uses the Extended Single Crochet (ESC)

Extended Single Crochet Instructions

Insert the hook into the stitch

-Yarn over and pull the yarn through the stitch. You will now have 2 loops on your hook.

-Yarn over and pull through only the first loop on your hook. You will still have 2 loops on your hook.

-Yarn over again and pull through both remaining loops.

Pike Stitch

Row 1: Chain 1. Starting with the 5th chain from the hook, *1 extended single crochet (ESC), chain 1, skip 1 chain, repeat from * across. End in last stitch with 1 ESC. Chain 3 and turn.

Row 2: Beginning in the 2nd ESC, work 1 ESC. *Chain 1, skip 1 chain, 1 ESC in the next ESC. Repeat from * across the row working your last ESC in the space made by the turning chain. Chain 3 and turn.

Rows 3-8: Repeat Row 2

(Adjustment Row) Take the opportunity before going into Round 4 to count your stitches. If you need to make an adjustment of stitches, use your ivory in single crochet to make the adjustment.
